Briefing and Action on the updates of the 2011 Complete Streets Policy. (Catherine Hernandez, Director of Transportation Department, (210) 207-5085, catherine.hernandez@sanantonio.gov)

Catherine Hernandez, Director of Transportation Department, stated this is an update to the 2011 Complete Streets Policy.

Zan Marshall, Senior Transportation Planner, stated the Complete Streets Policy consist of 3 key aspects, making streets safer and accessible, accommodate all needs of travel and street design based on context. Since 2011, standards have improved, and the policy no longer meets national standards. Updating the policy sets implementation goals and addresses how the City will improve safety and accessibility for all users and all modes of travel on City roadways. Implementing the policy, will require collaboration on the review and update of City code and such as the UDC. She stated they their public engagements events began late 2023 all thru May of 2024, to meet with AARP, Siclovia, Bike Community and other interested parties. The implementation of the policy update will begin within a year of its approval at Council.
