Tobacco Enforcement Program (TEP)

- Texas School Safety Center at Texas State University contracts with counties and municipalities to enable local law enforcement agencies to enforce the State of Texas' Tobacco Enforcement Program
- Program addresses illegal sale or distribution of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, and tobacco products to youth under the age of 21
- Interlocal agreement allows SAPD to participate in State of Texas Tobacco Enforcement Program
 - Enforcement Activity
 - Conducting buy/stings
- SAPD participation since 2011
- In FY 2024, SAPD performed 900 separate buy/stings at a reimbursement rate of \$125 per sting, with total revenue of \$112,500

Program Results – Contract 2024

Month	Buy/Sting	Citations	Reimbursement (\$125 per Buy/Sting)
January	90	6	\$11,250
February	100	11	\$12,500
March	160	23	\$20,000
April	170	24	\$21,250
May	220	20	\$27,500
June	160	17	\$20,000
Total	900	101	\$112,500

- 900 Stings Conducted in 2023 and 835 Stings Conducted in 2022

TEP Award 2025 and Funding



- Program Period:
 - January 2025*-August 31, 2025
 - *Estimated date of full execution sometime in January 2025
- Contract amount - \$125,000
 - \$125 per Buy/Sting
 - Maximum of 1000 stings
- Revenue
 - \$125,000
