Summary



An ordinance ratifying a grant application submission and acceptance of \$5,750,000 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program (LHRG).



Background



- The City of San Antonio was awarded its first Lead Hazard Reduction Grant in 1999
- Total Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Funding Received by the City: \$27M
- Assisted over 1400 families to date



Who We Serve



- Low-income families at or below 80% Area Median Income
- Household must include either expecting mothers or children under the age of 6
- Any home considered for the program must have been constructed prior to 1978
