These items will be provided at discount catalog pricing on an “as needed” basis and will be used to only buy parts for in-house repairs by City.</p> <p>This purchase was made utilizing a public health or safety exemption to allow BESD procurement of Ford brand specific OEM Parts to repair City owned vehicles. Due to the ongoing supply chain issues, BESD requires immediate procurement flexibility to engage multiple Ford OEM parts vendors. This exemption is necessary to safeguard the public’s wellbeing and various departments operational continuity, particularly public safety, and emergency response department.</p>
