Infrastructure Projects Update

SUMMARY:

Aviation Deputy Director Tim O’Krongley and Development Administrator Sam Rodriguez will brief the Airport Advisory Commission on the major infrastructure projects under development or in construction at the San Antonio International Airport and Stinson Municipal Airport, including the new Terminal Facility and Ground Load Facility projects. The briefing will provide information to the Commission for their input.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On November 18, 2021, City Council approved the Strategic Development Plan (SDP), a Master Planning process required by the Federal Aviation Administration to take place every eight to 10 years. This process is a comprehensive, long-range study of every physical aspect of an airport to ensure it meets projected demand and serves its designated role within the national airport system.

The SDP for the San Antonio International Airport identified airfield, terminal, roadway and supporting infrastructure improvements to support the economic growth of our region. The SDP developed into the Terminal Development Program (TDP), which is targeting completion of a new terminal and its associated enabling projects by the end of the second quarter of 2028. Since then, the City Council has approved contracts for the Executive Program Manager, Project Management Construction Management Services, Master Architect and Construction Manager at Risk for the new Terminal Facility. On December 10, 2024, the groundbreaking for the new Terminal facility was held which included the unveiling of the most recent renderings and Elevate/SAT, a new branding campaign to encompass the infrastructure programs at the San Antonio International Airport.

While the TDP is the largest program in the airport's history, the Airport has other new projects underway including the new Ground Load Facility and its enabling projects which will bring additional gates and aircraft parking to Terminal A and a new Ground Transportation Center, which will bring additional public parking spaces and centralize ground transportation services to one location at the Airport.
