High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Grant Program

- Grant Period: January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2026
- Total Grant Award: \$2,174,657.00
- General Fund : \$500,490
- Total Program: \$2,675,147
- Ordinance authorizes submission and acceptance up to \$2,174,657.00 from ONDCP plus additional grant award modifications up to 20%.

- 32nd year ONDCP has offered the HIDTA grant to SAPD. Initial budget amounts were:
 - 2021: \$2,173,086.
 - 2022: \$2,176,605.
 - 2023: \$2,178,947.
 - 2024: \$2,181,533.
- **Mission:** to reduce drug trafficking in the San Antonio metropolitan area by instituting innovative narcotic enforcement investigations and seizing illegally obtained assets in an effort to reduce the profitability of narcotics trafficking.

2024 HIDTA Performance Metrics



HIDTA SAPD works with Federal agencies (DEA, ATF, FBI, and HSI) to develop Federal criminal cases of highly organized drug trafficking networks rather than individuals operating independently at the street level.
