**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Public Works Department staff oversees and completes hundreds of construction projects every fiscal year. These infrastructure projects are completed through programs such as the Pedestrian Mobility Program within the 2017 Bond Program and 2022 Bond Program, Storm Water, the Infrastructure Management Program, the Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program, and several bond programs in the last two decades. As part of the City's commitment to delivering projects to completion on schedule and keeping stakeholders notified in a timely manner, the City's Communications & Engagement, Economic Development, and Public Works departments have been working together to devise and implement strategic tools and improved access to resources and information.

Staff from each of these departments will provide an overview of their respective efforts to improve transparency, support, accountability, and innovation throughout the life of these projects and beyond.

**ISSUE:**

Currently, there is not one comprehensive GIS map that includes information about past, current, and upcoming infrastructure projects. To help facilitate this effort, the Public Works Department has coordinated with a consultant, the Communications and Engagement Department, and the Information and Technology Services Department to develop a custom GIS-based program dashboard and a landing page on the City's website to report on Public Works managed capital infrastructure program projects.

Staff will brief City Council on its overall communication and program delivery efforts over the past year to support businesses and residents affected by construction.
