Settlement Agreement

SUMMARY:

This Ordinance authorizes a settlement of a state lawsuit styled Maria Compean v. City of San Antonio, in the 37th Judicial District Court, Bexar County, Texas, Cause No. 2023CI13382 for the amount of \$185,000.00 to Maria Compean. This settlement will be funded from the Self-Insured Liability Fund.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On August 19, 2022, at the intersection of Connelly Street and Nevada Street, an SAPD vehicle collided with Plaintiff's vehicle. The injuries sustained by Plaintiff in the accident required substantial medical care and attention culminating in spinal fusion surgery.

The parties have agreed to settle Maria Compean's claims for \$185,000.00, subject to City Council approval. The funds are available from the FY 2024 Liability Fund Adopted Budget.

Trial of this case is set for October 21, 2024, if settlement does not receive approval.

ISSUE:

Settlements over \$100,000 require City Council approval.

ALTERNATIVES:

If this settlement agreement is not approved by the City Council, the case will proceed to trial. It is in the best interest of the City to settle this matter to avoid the uncertainty and risks associated with litigation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

If the settlement is approved, \$185,000.00 will be paid by way of check, payable to Maria Compean and Carabin Shaw, P.C.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.
