**SUBJECT:**

Appointments to the SABC Soccer PFC Board of Directors.

**SUMMARY:**

An Ordinance re-appointing Alejandra Lopez (City of San Antonio), Patricia Muzquiz Cantor (City of San Antonio), Dan Curry (Bexar County) and Thomas Guevara (Bexar County) to the SABC Soccer PFC Board of Directors for the remainder of unexpired terms of office to expire May 31, 2025.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 303, authorizes municipalities to create one or more nonmember, nonstock, nonprofit public facility corporations to act on behalf of the sponsoring municipality to provide public facilities or facilities related to the renovation, expansion, redevelopment, construction, acquisition, provision, conveyance, leasing, owning, operating, and divesting of real property of the City.

On December 17, 2015, the City Council adopted resolution 2015-12-17-0068R which created the SABC Soccer PFC, appointed four (4) board directors, and authorized the Corporation to exercise powers for the purpose of supporting professional soccer within the City. The SABC Soccer PFC

oversees the lease agreement with Spurs Sports and Entertainment for management of Toyota Field as the home of the San Antonio FC.

As the Governing Body of the Corporation, the San Antonio City Council is authorized to appoint four (4) directors with the City and Bexar County each recommending two (2) appointees.

**ISSUE:**

The appointment term for the SABC Soccer PFC board members expired on May 31, 2023, with current members in holdover status. Bexar County Commissioners Court has communicated an interest in maintaining its current representatives on the SABC Soccer PFC. The City Council, in its capacity as the governing body of the Corporation, is required to approve all director appointments.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Convention and Sports Facilities Department staff can continue to coordinate with Bexar County and the City Council on the filling of SABC Soccer PFC director seats.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Ordinance has no fiscal impact.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends re-appointment of the current SABC Soccer PFC Board of Directors.
