ORDINANCE

**APPROVING THE MEMORIAL STREET NAME DESIGNATION ON A
PORTION OF NORTH SAN JACINTO STREET, LOCATED BETWEEN
WEST MARTIN STREET AND MORALES STREET, AS JANIE
BARRERA MEMORIAL WAY.**

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WHEREAS, the Development Services Department staff (staff) received a request to grant a memorial designation to a portion of North San Jacinto Street between the cross streets of West Martin Street and Morales Street to honor the memory of Janie Barrera, the founder of LiftFund LLC; and

WHEREAS, staff began implementing this request through the street naming/memorial designation process as required by Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, staff forwarded this request to all City of San Antonio departments and outside agencies for review and acquiescence and no opposition has been identified; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted a technical review finding it to conform to City Code requirements for memorial designations; and

WHEREAS, staff properly posted and mailed notice of this request to attach the memorial designation to said street to abutting property owners, notice requirements for giving the memorial designation of the street have been satisfied in accordance with Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Historic and Design Review Commission held a public hearing on November 1, 2023 and recommended approval, a community meeting was held on November 16, 2023, and Planning Commission held a public hearing on December 13, 2023 and also recommended approval for the memorial designation of “Janie Barrera Memorial Way”; **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. North San Jacinto Street, between West Martin Street and Morales Street, is hereby given the memorial designation of “Janie Barrera Memorial Way.” The location is more specifically depicted in **ATTACHMENT 1**. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

SECTION 2: Funds xxxxxxxx (to be provided).

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SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective 10 days after passage.
