The City Council convened a special meeting in the Norma S. Rodriguez Council Chamber in the Municipal Plaza Building beginning at 2:09 p.m. City Clerk Debbie Racca-Sittre took the Roll Call noting a quorum with the following Council Members present:

ITEMS

1. Consideration of applicants and selection of up to three candidates to interview to temporarily fill the City Council District 2 office. [Debbie Racca-Sittre, City Clerk]

City Clerk Debbie Racca-Sittre presented an overview of the vacancy and process.

Mayor Nirenberg recessed the meeting into Executive Session at 2:13 p.m. to discuss the process in consultation with the City Attorney's Office pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

Mayor Nirenberg reconvened the meeting in Open Session at 2:21 p.m. and announced that no action was taken in Executive Session.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mando Flores, representing AFSCME Local 2021 and Alicia Williams, on behalf of the staff of City Council District 2, spoke in support of the appointment of Leo Castillo-Anguiano.

Councilmember Cabello Havrda moved to forward Leo Castillo-Anguiano to be interviewed for the Temporary District 2 position. Councilmember Kaur seconded the motion. The motion prevailed by the following vote:
