# Background



- In September 2018, City Council approved the initial agreement with Alamo Community College District (ACCD) to develop a dental hygiene program for students and a community dental clinic.
- Due to the COVID-19 global pandemic, the opening of the school was delayed from August 2021 to August 2023.
- The first cohort of students provided oral health services to 261 community members in the spring of 2024.
- Students will be expected to serve a minimum of 600 patients per academic year.

# Background



- **ACCD Funding Agreement:**
  - Funding agreement for the development of a dental hygiene program and a community dental clinic.
  - \$500,000 was paid upon contract execution.
- **Contract Amendment:**
  - Changes to the scope of work, updating the first student cohort enrollment date, and programmatic requirements.
- **ACCD Facility Use Agreement:**
  - Allows Metro Health use of Palo Alto College's Dental Hygiene Clinic to provide onsite dental hygiene clinical services.

# Fiscal Impact



- Amendment to the agreement with ACCD:
  - No-cost Amendment
  - Total Contract Value: \$500,000.00
  - Term: January 30, 2018 through September 30, 2029
  - No fiscal impact to City's General Fund

# Fiscal Impact




- Facility use agreement with ACCD:
  - No-cost agreement
  - Term: Upon execution through September 30, 2029
  - No fiscal impact to City's General Fund
