ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO AN
AGREEMENT WITH ANGEL STAFFING, INC. FOR EMERGENCY
MEDICAL STAFFING SERVICES FOR THE SAN ANTONIO
METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT'S PUBLIC HEALTH
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM TO INCREASE THE
COMPENSATION BY THE AMOUNT OF \$2,718,750.00 FOR A
TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT UP TO \$3,187,500.00, INCLUSIVE
OF RENEWALS.**

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WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) provides effective health and medical response in the event of an emergency, disaster, or public health incident for the City of San Antonio and Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, through the agreement with Angel Staffing, Inc., Metro Health utilizes their trained and licensed medical and professional personnel deployed at sites on as needed basis, as determined by Metro Health; and

WHEREAS, there are currently two grants that fund temporary staffing to augment clinical capacity during peak seasons and modify clinic workflows; and

WHEREAS, the first is the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Immunizations and Vaccines for Children Program Grant that has provided COVID-19 and Bridge Access Program supplemental funds to improve vaccine access in Bexar County for those that are uninsured or whose insurance does not cover immunizations; and

WHEREAS, additional clinicians are needed to provide vaccines at pop-up clinic events throughout the community and also increase capacity in Metro Health's Immunizations Clinic during the back-to-school season; and

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2022, through Ordinance 2022-03-03-0151, City Council approved the initial emergency medical staffing services agreement with Angel Staffing, Inc. for a term ending August 31, 2024, in an amount up to \$187,500.00, with the option to renew for three, one-year terms in the amount up to \$93,750.00 annually for a total contract amount up to \$468,750.00; and

WHEREAS, services are used on as needed basis in the event of emergency disaster or public health incident; and

WHEREAS, due to supplementary funding from the CDC, additional deliverables have resulted in a need to continue to provide emergency medical staffing services; and

WHEREAS, additional funding in the amount of \$2,718,750.00, for a total amended contract value up to \$3,187,500.00, to Angel Staffing, Inc. will ensure continued support for vaccination services during peak seasons; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is authorized to execute an amendment to an agreement with Angel Staffing, Inc., for emergency medical staffing services to increase the compensation by the amount of \$2,718,750.00 for a total contract amount up to \$3,187,500.00, inclusive of renewals. A copy of the amendment in substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. Current funding is available from General Ledger 5201040, Internal Order Number 136000001756 and Fund 2103600008 entitled "COVID-19 Vaccine Mobile Clinic", for a total amount up to \$2,290,750.00. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Angel Staffing, Inc. upon issuance of a purchase order.

SECTION 3. Current funding is available from General Ledger 5201040, Internal Order Number 136000000932 and Fund 2202238020 entitled "MPOX Crisis FY23", for a total amount up to \$428,000.00. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Angel Staffing, Inc. upon issuance of a purchase order.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance ratifies and authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute an amendment in the following circumstances: (A) an increase in contract funding in an amount not exceeding (a) twenty-five percent (25%) of the total amount of this contract or (b) \$25,000.00, whichever is lesser amount; provided, however, that the cumulative total of all amendments increasing funding and executed without City Council approval pursuant to this subsection during the term of this contract shall not exceed the foregoing amount; (B) no cost extensions up to two years; (C) budget adjustments authorized by the funding agency so long as the total dollar amount of the budget remains unchanged; (D) modifications to the Scope of Work due to the adjustment described in subsection (A) of this Section or for any other reason, so long as the terms of the amendment are reasonably within the parameters set forth in the original Scope of Work; and (E) changes in state or federal regulations mandated by the funding agency.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
