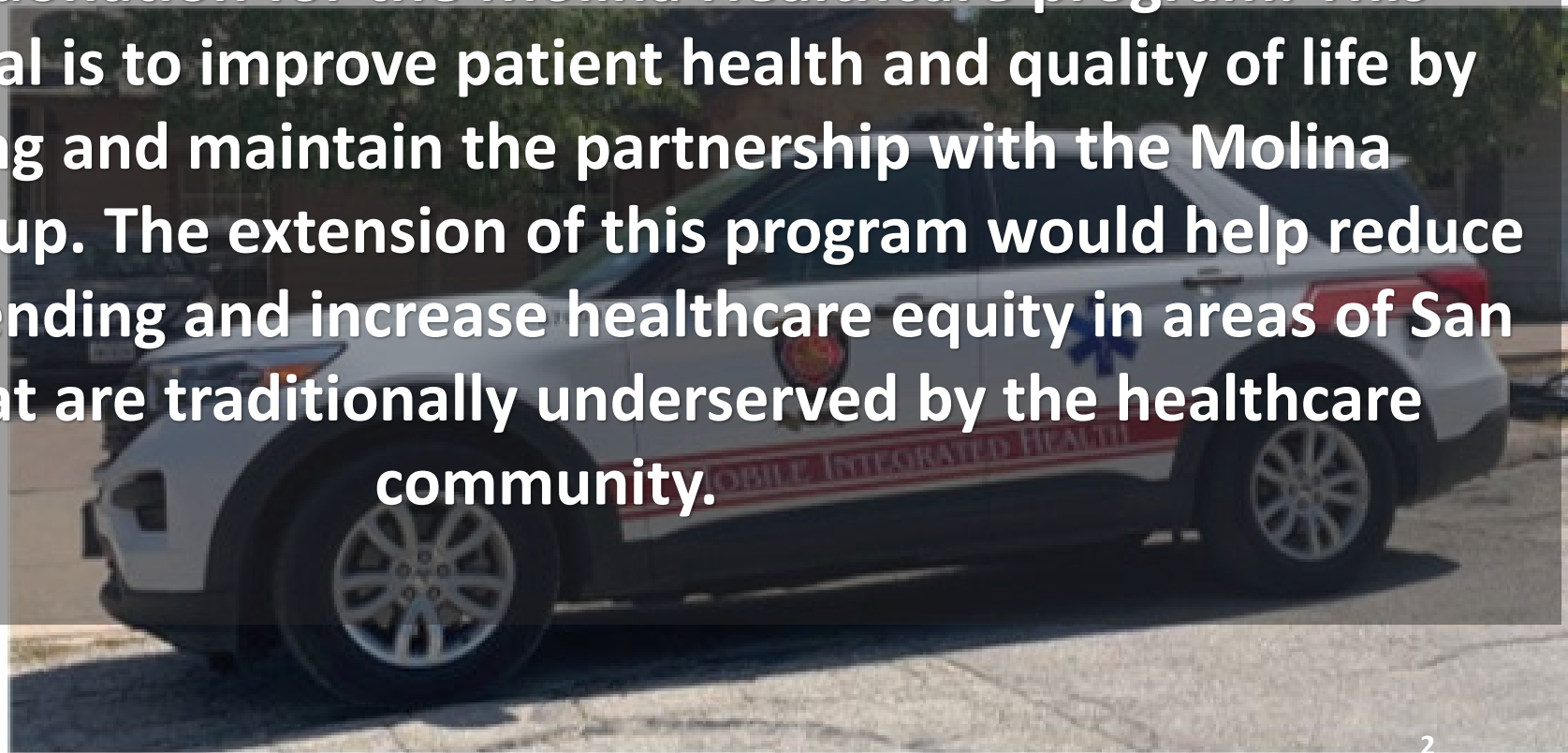

Purpose

The SAFD Mobile Integrated Healthcare program would like to renew this donation for the Molina Healthcare program. This program's goal is to improve patient health and quality of life by establishing and maintain the partnership with the Molina Healthcare group. The extension of this program would help reduce healthcare spending and increase healthcare equity in areas of San Antonio that are traditionally underserved by the healthcare community.



Plan of Action



Paramedic will conduct a minimum of one (1) to three (3) in person home visits per week with the Member during the enrollment period.

Paramedic will provide Molina Healthcare with detailed reports on a weekly basis for each member enrolled in the program

Paramedic will notify Molina Healthcare immediately if the member has a change in health condition
