SUMMARY:

Street Name Change Case ADDR-SNC-23-12700002: A request by Christy Orloski on behalf of Nagels Guns Store for approval of a resolution to create a memorial designation on El Mio Drive, located between Melliff Drive and San Pedro Avenue, as Bobby Nagel Memorial Way.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The memorial designation request is being submitted by Christy Orloski on behalf of Nagel's Gun Store.

Analysis and Notification Process:

This street name change would require zero (0) address changes

The segment consists of approximately nine hundred and seventy-six (976) linear feet, two (2) ground mounted signs.
