SUBJECT: Resolution for a large area rezoning of property located within the Harvard Place/Eastlawn Neighborhood
DATE: July 6, 2023

Issue Proposed for Consideration:

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the Governance Committee:

A resolution to review and rezone properties located within the Harvard Place/Eastlawn Neighborhood bounded by East Houston Street to the South, N. New Braunfels Avenue to the West, and the Union Pacific Railroad Tracks to the North and East.

Brief Background:

Current zoning of the properties within the boundaries show single family uses that are zoned for multi-family and industrial uses. This resolution will direct staff to conduct an analysis of the current land uses, bring forward any appropriate plan amendments and/or zoning changes that are consistent with the Future Land Use Plan and bring non-conforming current land uses into conformity with appropriate zoning at no cost to affected property-owners.

This proposal seeks to rezone the properties and the land use as necessary to align the zoning with the existing use.
