ORDINANCE

**ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE SOUTHWEST TEXAS
REGIONAL ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR TRAUMA IN AN
AMOUNT UP TO \$409,644.00 FOR THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE
DEPARTMENT MENTAL HEALTH UNIT PROGRAM FOR
INTENSIVE CARE COORDINATION FOR THE PERIOD OF
JANUARY 1, 2025 TO DECEMBER 31, 2025.**

WHEREAS, the Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council for Trauma (STRAC) was established to facilitate the development, implementation, and operation of a regional comprehensive trauma and emergency healthcare system; and

WHEREAS, STRAC has funds in an amount up to \$409,644.00 for the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) Mental Health Unit, for the Program for Intensive Care Coordination (PICC); and

WHEREAS, the funds would be used to pay overtime to staff two SAPD Mental Health Officer positions for forty-eight hours a week and one supervisor position for eighteen hours a week;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Chief of SAPD or designee, are hereby authorized to accept funds an amount up to \$409,644.00 from the STRAC that will be used by the SAPD Mental Health Unit for the PICC to pay overtime to staff two SAPD Mental Health Officer positions for forty-eight hours a week and one supervisor position for eighteen hours a week for the period of January 1, 20245 to December 31, 20245, and are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said acceptance.

SECTION 2. Funds received for this ordinance for PICC will be deposited in Fund 29817000, Internal Order 817000000043 and General Ledger 6301120. These funds are authorized to be appropriated per the attached budget.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, provided that it is passed by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
