Summary



- Requesting approval to name the Heritage Park Multigenerational Center the “Barbara ‘Robbie’ Robinette Community and Senior Center”
- The new center, located in Council District 4, is anticipated to open in November 2024
- A Public Hearing to discuss the center name was held May 21, 2024
- The Naming Committee unanimously approved the name recommendation



Background

- March 13, 2023, City Clerk's Office received written recommendation and the Naming Committee was established
- Public Hearing was held May 21, 2024
- Public Notice included:
 - Mailing to residents and businesses within 200 feet of the facility
 - Published in the Express News
 - City of San Antonio News Release
 - Postings on DHS Social Media
 - Informational slides on TVSA
 - City Council District Newsletter
 - Posted at the Cortez Senior Center Bulletin Board
- The Public Hearing garnered a total of 4 responses with 100% of responses in approval of the recommended name

Public Hearing



- Public Hearing was held May 21, 2024 at Cody Elementary School, 10403 Dugas Drive
- Feedback on the proposed naming included:
 - One email response in support of proposed naming
 - Response from 4 community members at the public hearing in support of the recommended name
- The Naming Committee approved the recommendation to name the site the “Barbara ‘Robbie’ Robinette Community and Senior Center”
- Should the proposed name not be approved, the City would restart the naming process



Recommendation

- DHS recommends approval of the suggested name for the new multigenerational center to the “Barbara ‘Robbie’ Robinette Community and Senior Center”
