

RFCA #23-191292

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Chief of Police for the City of San Antonio or designee, hereby authorizes the submission of a grant application and acceptance of funds upon award, not to exceed \$6,250,000.00, from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), for a Hiring Program grant, and authorizing a General Fund contribution of \$22,839,720.00 establishing a budget and personnel complement of 50 Uniform City Positions for the period October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2028, contingent upon budget approval.

SECTION 2. Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum of \$6,250,000.00 will be appropriated from DOJ COPS, is hereby authorized. The proposed budget, including a General Fund cash matching contribution of \$22,839,720.00 and a proposed personnel complement of fifty (50) positions, is approved and attached hereto as **Attachment II**. A formal budget will be provided upon acceptance of funds.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
