Background



- Metro Health formed the Food Policy Council of San Antonio (FPCSA) under a Communities Putting Prevention to Work (CPPW) grant awarded in March 2010.
- FPCSA was incorporated as a Texas nonprofit in May 2012.
- FPCSA serves as a stakeholder forum to support a healthy, sustainable and just local food systems for people, the environment, the economy and community.

Background



- In September 2023, City Council authorized funding the FPCSA for an Urban Farming Pilot Program.
- The proposed agreement will allow the FPCSA to provide capacity-building grants to at least three urban farms located within the City of San Antonio.
- Awardees of the Urban Farming Pilot Program will use funds to create new urban farms, or expand, enhance, and sustain current urban farms.

Fiscal Impact



- Agreement with FPCSA:
 - Term: upon execution through September 30, 2025
 - Total contract value: \$60,000.00
 - Funding for this agreement is available from the General Fund FY 2024 Adopted Budget
