

ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$498,000.00 ANNUALLY, INCLUDED IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2025 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) FREEIT DATA SOLUTIONS, INC., FOR ZERO TRUST PRODUCT A, (B) FREEIT DATA SOLUTIONS, INC., FOR ZERO TRUST PRODUCT B, AND (C) CARAHSOFT TECHNOLOGY CORP., FOR ZERO TRUST PRODUCT C.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Freeit Data Solutions, Inc., utilizing the State of Texas Department of Information Resources ("DIR") contract number DIR-CPO-5330, to provide the City of San Antonio ("City") with Zero Trust - Product A for an estimated total cost of \$1,234,234.66; and

WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Freeit Data Solutions, Inc., utilizing DIR contract number DIR-CPO-5175, to provide the City with Zero Trust - Product B for an estimated total cost of \$423,033.60; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 2054.0565 of the Texas Government Code, accepting this offer through DIR meets the requirements for competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act (the "Act"), Chapter 791, Texas Government Code permits local governmental entities to enter into interlocal agreements for the performance of governmental functions, including administrative functions, such as purchasing, in order to promote efficiencies and effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, the Region VIII Education Service Center ("Region VIII") is the Texas administrator of a cooperative purchasing program known as The Interlocal Purchasing System ("TIPS") Program; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Region VIII pursuant to Ordinance Number 2009-12-10-1002, authorizing use of contracts procured by TIPS; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to utilize the TIPS contract number 220105 with Carahsoft Technology Corp., for Zero Trust - Product C for an estimated total cost of \$578,405.56; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following offers from (A) Freeit Data Solutions, Inc., utilizing the State of Texas Department of Information Resources ("DIR") contract number DIR-CPO-5330, to provide the City with Zero Trust - Product A for an estimated total cost of \$1,234,234.66; (B) Freeit Data

Solutions, Inc., utilizing DIR contract number DIR-CPO-5175, to provide the City with Zero Trust - Product B for an estimated total cost of \$423,033.60; and (C) Carahsoft Technology Corp., utilizing the TIPS contract number 220105 for Zero Trust - Product C for an estimated total cost of \$578,405.56, are hereby accepted subject to and contingent upon the deposit of any required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation sheets is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein for an estimated annual cost of \$498,000.00. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2025 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
