REGULAR BUSINESS

Meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm by Vice Chairman Scott Halty, who presided as Acting Chair in the absence of Chairwoman Francine Romero. Roll call was taken by Vice Chairman Halty.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Vice Chairman Halty asked for approval of the minutes for the March 26, 2025 meeting. Mr. Thomas Marsalia motioned for approval of the minutes as amended. Mr. Rader Gilleland seconded. Motion carried.

ITEMS OF COMMUNITY INTEREST

- Mr. Phillip Covington stated that there was a total of 187,349 acres protected under the EAPP and he presented an updated map of the protected properties under the program.

- Mr. Covington stated that the Edwards Aquifer Authority closed on the Maverick Ranch property. The City of San Antonio signed the deed as the Trustee and enforcer of the restrictive covenants within the deed.
- Mr. Covington stated that the EAPP met with representatives of the local Homeland Security Department. Mr. Covington stated they are conducting an aquifer vulnerability study for the Edwards Aquifer in coordination with San Antonio Water System and gathered information on the EAPP initiative and accomplishments.
