AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF A 10-YEAR LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE FOR THE CONTINUED USE OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY LOCATED NEAR LACKLAND AIR FORCE BASE, COUNCIL DISTRICT 4, FOR A COMMUNICATIONS CABLE SYSTEM AND SUPPORTING FACILITIES FOR A LICENSE RENEWAL FEE OF \$14,866, WHICH WILL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES FUND.

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WHEREAS, the United States Air Force desires to continue the use of certain rights-of-way within the City of San Antonio for the purpose of maintaining fiber optic cable facilities; and

WHEREAS, the proposed fiber optic cable facilities cross under the City's right-of-way to provide telecommunications connectivity as set forth in the Original Authorizing Ordinance No. 59662 passed on October 30, 1984 and in the renewal agreement Ordinance No. 2010-09-02-0742 passed on September 2, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the installation, maintenance, and repair of fiber optic cable facilities over or under the public right-of-way will be done in a manner consistent with the terms of the License Agreement attached as **Exhibit A**; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and their designee are authorized to execute a renewal of the 10-year License Agreement in substantially the same form as set forth in **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or their designee is hereby authorized to execute the License Agreement and any and all documents necessary to fulfill the purpose and intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Funds received for this ordinance will be deposited in Fund 74001000, Internal Order 209000000046 and General Ledger Account 74001000.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes, or in the event eight affirmative votes are not received, on the tenth day after passage by majority vote.
