Diana Uriegas requested more speed bumps on Roosevelt Avenue.

Carl Markle stated that a violent white-collar crime ring had kidnapped him and he felt that law enforcement was assisting with crime, rather than helping.

Jason Andrew complained about illegal actions at the Bexar County Courthouse and stated that he could not get a job because of immigrants.

Martha Huerta stated that she was evicted last Monday and needed help because her son was in detention.

Joshua Hinson stated that he was unlawfully arrested over sidewalk chalk art and claimed that police had killed a jaywalker after they ran away from the police.
