Background

- The Department of Labor awarded the City \$2.98M in funding from the **Apprenticeship Building America (ABA) Grant** to expand and enhance pre-apprenticeships and registered apprenticeship programs
- Grant requirements include periodic reporting in specific formats
- A portion of ABA Grant funding may be used for a client and case management system

Contract Details



- WDO seeks a contract with Lyncverse Technologies to host MyOneFlow Client and Case Management System utilizing the Texas Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS)
- Three-year term with two, one-year renewal options for an estimated total contract value of \$276,650
- The first-year costs for the software license subscription and implementation services will be \$78,650, funded by the ABA Grant
- Also serves as a pilot program to consider use of the software for federally-funded grants in other City departments

Staff Recommendation



- Staff recommends approval of this contract with Lyncverse Technologies utilizing the Texas Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) to implement Empyra's MyOneFlow Client and Case Management System for total estimated value of \$276,650
