



<p>Authorizing the submission of a grant application not to exceed \$6,250,000.00, from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), for a Hiring Program grant, and authorizing a General Fund contribution of \$22,839,720 for the hiring of 50 Sworn Police Officer positions for the period October 2024 through September 2027, contingent upon budget approval.</p> <p>The COPS Hiring Grant will provide funding to hire 50 new Police Officers which will be assigned to address <i>Building Legitimacy and Trust</i> in the community. Officers will deploy to partner and engage with community stakeholders including residents, businesses, and faith-based organizations to prioritize and collectively strengthen the community's response to crime and criminal activity and focus on enhancing and maintaining community trust and legitimacy between law enforcement and the communities we serve – to include building trust in immigrant communities.</p> <p>This action will continue the Department's commitment to address community needs and concerns through traditional policing as well as innovative strategies which provide services and resources to the community.</p>
