ORDINANCE

**APPROVING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE
PROGRAM FOR THE 119TH U.S. CONGRESS.**

WHEREAS, development of the City’s Federal Legislative Program began in July 2024 with the collaboration of City departments and our Federal consultant team; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Program priorities, drawn from the City of San Antonio’s strategic plans previously adopted by the City Council, are designed to be strategic and impactful, align with the priorities of the San Antonio community, and help advance a resilient and sustainable city organization; and

WHEREAS, for the 119th U.S. Congress, which convened on January 3, 2025, the City’s Federal priorities consist of seven pillars, which include Economic and Community Development; Military Protection; Public Safety & Homeland Security; Infrastructure, Resiliency & Transportation; Workforce; Public Health & Human Services; and Advancement of Community Interests; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2024, the City Council Intergovernmental Relations Committee voted to forward the Program to the full City Council at a B Session which was held on February 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the full City Council to approve the City of San Antonio’s Federal Legislative Program for the 119th U.S. Congress; **NOW, THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City of San Antonio’s Federal Legislative Program for the 119th U.S. Congress is authorized and approved. A copy of the Program is attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. The Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective 10 days after passage.
