**ORDINANCE**

**ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF AN  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN  
ANTONIO AND BEXAR COUNTY TO CONTRIBUTE CITY  
COUNCIL DISTRICT 9 NEIGHBORHOOD ACCESS AND  
MOBILITY PROGRAM FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,000 TO  
BEXAR COUNTY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF THREE SETS OF  
ADVANCE SCHOOL FLASHING BEACONS NEAR LADY BIRD  
JOHNSON HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS.**

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**WHEREAS**, Lady Bird Johnson High School is located in north central San Antonio within Council District 9 near the intersection of Bulverde Road and TPC Parkway. While many of the students who attend Johnson High School reside in San Antonio, the main roadway to the school is through Bulverde Road, located in Bexar County near the school. There are currently school zones on Bulverde Road and TPC Parkway within Bexar County that only have static signage for the zone and no school flashers. As a result, many drivers do not abide by the lower school speed limit and often speed while students walk and drive to the school; and

**WHEREAS**, to help heighten motorist attention to the existing school zones, Council District 9 has requested overhead school flashing beacons be installed on Bulverde Road and TPC Parkway. Since these flashers are located within Bexar County, Bexar County Public Works agency owns, installs, and maintains the flashers; and

**WHEREAS**, to expedite the installation of these flashers, Council District 9 has agreed to fund the installation cost for the flashers using funds available from the NAMP fund balance. Once installed, Bexar County will operate and maintain the advance school flashing beacons.; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends approving the execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County to contribute City Council District 9 Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program (NAMP) funds in the amount of \$90,000.00 to Bexar County for the installation of three sets of advance school flashing beacons near Lady Bird Johnson High School campus; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Public Works Department or designee, is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County to contribute City Council District 9 Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program funds in the amount of \$90,000.00 to Bexar County for the installation of three sets of advance

school flashing beacons near Lady Bird Johnson High School campus. A copy of the Agreement in substantially final form is attached as **Exhibit A**.

**SECTION 2.** Funding in the amount of \$90,000.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 2303500009 and General Ledger 5201140 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

**SECTION 3.** Payment is authorized to Bexar County and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
