#### **SUMMARY:**

Staff will provide a presentation on the Committee on Emergency Preparedness (CEP) recommendations tracking dashboard to the Municipal Utilities Committee

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

From February 13, 2021 to February 19, 2021, the continental United States experienced a severe winter storm referred to as Winter Storm Uri, which significantly impacted the City of San Antonio.

On February 22, 2021, the Mayor created the Committee on Emergency Preparedness and tasked the Committee with studying the event to determine what happened and to provide recommendations on what needs to be done to better prepare for future winter weather emergency events. The Committee's Report was presented to City Council on June 24, 2021.

The report consisted of 49 recommendations to the City of San Antonio, CPS Energy, and San Antonio Water Systems (SAWS).

Beginning in August 2021, the City of San Antonio, CPS Energy, and SAWS have briefed the Municipal Utilities Committee on their organization's progress at completing the recommendations.

On November 30, 2021, the Municipal Utilities Committee asked that a dashboard be created and posted on the interim committee website so the public could track each organization's progress.
