On January 25, 2022 the Aquifer Protection and Evaluation Section of the San Antonio Water System (SAWS) received an Aquifer Protection Plan issued by your office concerning the property referenced above. This letter serves as certification that the requirements of Chapter 34, Article VI, Division 6, Sections 34-910 and 34-911 of the San Antonio City Code have been complied with as they apply to the above-referenced development. Copper Canyon, approximately 209.34 acres, is a Category 3 property as defined by the Aquifer Protection Ordinance (Ordinance No. 81491) of the City of San Antonio Code.

The recipient of this letter is authorized to commence development activities as provided for, and subject to all of the terms and conditions of Chapter 34, Article VI, Division 6, of the San Antonio City Code. Pursuant to Section 34-910 of said Code, this Letter of Certification will expire if not utilized within three years from the date of this document.
