**SUMMARY:**

A briefing on potential locations for Resiliency Hubs and community engagement.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On January 18th, 2022, the Public Safety Committee received a briefing on the implementation of an emergency preparedness plan which included the concept of resiliency planning and resiliency hubs.

The San Antonio Fire Department Office of Emergency Management will provide a briefing on potential locations for four resiliency hubs and a community input process to finalize locations.

Resiliency Hubs will be used as temporary emergency shelter during a weather event such as a winter storm or flood event. These locations would leverage established, trusted, and community-managed facilities that are used year-round as neighborhood centers for community-building activities.
