# BACKGROUND



- Currently, 89% of CDCs are not certified for quality in San Antonio.
- In early 2019, Pre-K 4 SA began a Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) Cohort, specifically targeting centers throughout the city that would like to become Texas Rising Star (TRS) certified.
- In June 2021, Pre-K 4 SA was approached by the Holt Family Foundation, who had a desire to support a child care center near their headquarters that was participating in our Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) cohort.

# BACKGROUND



- Staff identified Holli-Hills Day Care Center as a potential site.
- Staff met with Holli-Hills and HOLT on site to evaluate center operations and improvements needed to achieve a more quality program.
- Staff worked with Holli-Hills to craft a development plan in alignment with the vision the HOLT Family Foundation wished to achieve.
- Pre-K 4 SA applied for and was awarded a \$100K grant from the HOLT Family Foundation to support quality improvement efforts at Holli-Hills.

# SCOPE

Pre-K 4 SA has been in discussions with Holli-Hills to identify feasible and effective measures to improve quality with support from HOLT Family Foundation grant.

## Holli-Hills will:

- Develop an annual action plan in cooperation with Corporation staff; and
- Provide monthly progress reports towards project milestones.

## Pre-K 4 SA will:

- Support Holli-Hills quality improvement efforts; and
- Provide Holli-Hills with administrative and coordination support from Pre-K 4 SA staff



Milestone
Increase enrollment to full capacity
Obtain CDA Credentialing for all Staff
Obtain Texas Rising Star, 4 Star Provider Certification
Implement Frog Street Curriculum in each classroom
Develop family engagement space and programming
Develop model outdoor learning environment
Improve center aesthetics
Matriculate into Shared Services Alliance

# RECOMMENDATION



Staff recommends the Board approve a memorandum of agreement between Pre-K 4 SA and Holli-Hills Day Care Center, and accept a contribution of \$100,000.00 from the HOLT Family Foundation to support the partnership.
