

RFCA #22-184622

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Historic Preservation or designee, hereby authorizes ratification of a grant application and acceptance of grant funds in an amount up to \$25,000.00 from The Texas Historical Commission for the development of a preservation plan and recommendations for the Bungalow Colony at Port San Antonio by September 2023, with a match requirement including in-kind services from the Office of Historic Preservation's 2022 . A copy of said application is on file with the Office of Historic Preservation.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Historic Preservation or designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3 Upon acceptance of this award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 will be appropriated in said funds. A final budget, including Internal Orders and GL Accounts, will be submitted by the Office of Historic Preservation upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
