**ORDINANCE**

**APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$671,350.15, INCLUDED IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2022 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) AIRGAS USA, LLC, FOR LABORATORY, MEDICAL, AND WELDING GASES; (B) SAMSARA, INC., FOR VIDEO RECORDERS AND A TRACKING SYSTEM; (C) JOHNSON CONTROLS, INC., FOR CHILLERS AND HVAC EQUIPMENT PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE FOR CITY TOWER; (D) PEDIATRIC EMERGENCY STANDARDS, INC., FOR HANDTEVY MOBILE MEDICATION MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES FOR THE PEDIATRIC RESUSCITATION SYSTEM; (E) EBSCO PUBLISHING FOR AN EBSCO DATABASE SUBSCRIPTION FOR THE SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC LIBRARY; AND (F) SELRICO SERVICES, INC., FOR ADDITIONAL CUSTODIAL SERVICES.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance approves contracts with (A) Airgas USA, LLC, for laboratory, medical, and welding gases; (B) Samsara, Inc., for video event recorders and a tracking system; (C) Johnson Controls, Inc., for chillers and HVAC equipment preventative maintenance for City Tower; (D) Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc., for HandTevy Mobile Medication Management software subscription services for the pediatric resuscitation system; (E) an amendment to the EBSCO Publishing contract for the EBSCO database subscription for the San Antonio Public Library; and (F) a change order to the contract with Selrico Services, Inc., for custodial services for the Information Technology Services Department at Port SA – Alamo Regional Security Operations Center (ARSOC); and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(7)(A), which provides for any items that are available only from a sole source of supply; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance approves one low bid contract, two cooperative procurements which meet the requirements under the terms of the Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 2009-02-12-0102, one contract and one amendment procured on the basis of the sole source exemption, and a change order; and

**WHEREAS**, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The following bids and offers to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: (A) Airgas USA, LLC, for laboratory, medical, and welding gases; (B) Samsara, Inc., for video event recorders and a tracking system; (C) Johnson Controls, Inc., for chillers and HVAC equipment preventative maintenance for City Tower; (D) Pediatric Emergency Standards, Inc., for HandTevy Mobile Medication Management software subscription services for the pediatric resuscitation system; (E) an amendment to the EBSCO Publishing contract for the EBSCO database subscription for the San Antonio Public Library; and (F) a change order to the contract with Selrico Services, Inc., for custodial services for the Information Technology Services Department at Port SA – Alamo Regional Security Operations Center (ARSOC). The bid tabulation sheets, amendment and change order are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2022 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
