Background

August 2021 – March 31, 2022: BCFS operated the Bexar County Regional Infusion Center where 12,867 infusions were administered

March 22, 2022: Federal HRSA Grant funding ended

April 25, 2022: Test and Treat Center opened to provide testing and treatment services to uninsured residents experiencing COVID symptoms



Background

- Test and Treat Center offers two antiviral treatment options at no cost to patients
 - Monoclonal Antibody Infusions: offered on-site
 - Paxlovid Oral Medication: offered through partnership between BCFS and HEB
- As of May 31, 2022, over 573 patients served
 - 170 treatments to include over 88 doses of Paxlovid
 - Center is supported through FEMA reimbursement



Fiscal Impact

- Initial Term: April 22, 2022 through June 30, 2022
 - Initial Amount: \$800,000.00
- Extension: July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022
 - Extension Amount: Additional \$939,663.00
- Total Cumulative Amount: \$1,739,663.00
 - \$1,575,759.95 funded w/ FEMA Reimbursements
 - Cash Match: \$163,903.05 funded by the General Fund



Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of an ordinance accepting funds from FEMA in an amount up to \$1,575,759.95 and ratifying the execution of a Professional Services Agreement with BCFS Health and Human Services for COVID testing and treatment in the amount up to \$800,000.00 for a term ending June 30, 2022 and authorizing the option to extend the term to end December 31, 2022 for an additional amount up to \$939,663 and a cash match up to \$163,903.05.
