

ORDINANCE 2022-06-23-0518

**APPROVING THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF A
GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000.00, FROM
THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE FOR CONSULTATION
SERVICES TO FACILITATE THE HISTORICAL AFRICAN
AMERICAN NEIGHBORHOODS SURVEY.**

WHEREAS, the Office of Historic Preservation aims to better represent the African American community of San Antonio's extensive history through a historic resource survey funded by the National Park Service (NPS) Underrepresented Community Grant (UCG); and

WHEREAS, this multi-year initiative will include extensive community engagement with organizations and will complement the African American Cultural Context Statement that is currently being drafted by the Office of Historic Preservation; and

WHEREAS, this project is in support of several local and federal historic preservation goals, including the City of San Antonio's annual obligation to the National Park Service to keep an inventory of historic properties; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will allow the Office of Historic Preservation to engage a consultant to complete the field survey and historic resources report and this information, combined with staff research and community participation, will result in at least one new nomination to the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has preliminarily been awarded a grant of \$50,000.00 to complete this project by Spring 2025; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Historic Preservation or designee, authorizes the submission and acceptance of a grant in an amount up to \$50,000.00 from the National Park Service's Underrepresented Community Grant Program for consultation services to facilitate the Historical African American Neighborhoods Survey. A copy of the application is on file with the Office of Historic Preservation.


SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Office of Historic Preservation or designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 will be appropriated in said funds. A final budget, including Internal Orders and GL Accounts, will be submitted by the Office of Historic Preservation upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


