Board Member Reports

Mr. Greg Hammer, District Seven

- Announced that he's resigning from the Linear Creekway Advisory Board and is moving out of town.

STAFF REPORT (Brandon Ross, Parks and Recreation Department)

Mr. Ross gave update on the Linear Creekway trails:

- Mr. Ross stated that with the completion of the Alazan Creek Greenway, 92 miles have been completed to date. There are also 9 miles under construction, eight of which will be completed by November. When the eight are completed, this will add up to 100 miles of completed greenway trail.
 - The board and staff briefly discussed the "100 mile" milestone and a potential celebratory event.
- Mr. Ross reported that he is working also on scopes for new Greenway Trails to be funded by the 2022 Bond.
 - Mr. Ross is working on the Huebner Creek Greenway and Medical Center Park in cooperation with the Medical Alliance, Medical Foundation and their design team. He is also discussing the potential for a pedestrian bridge over Babcock Road with design engineers.

- Other Bond-funded greenway trails are in early planning stages, including:
 - French Creek Greenway (O.P Schnabel to Loop 1604)
 - Beitel Creek Greenway (Thousand Oaks to Perrin Homestead) and El Dorado link
 - Maverick Creek Greenway (via UTSA campus from UTSA Blvd to Loop 1604)

Ms. Melinda Cerda gladly announced that Mr. Brandon Ross had recently been promoted to the position of Capital Programs Manager. The board members were glad to hear this news.
