

## Medicaid Administrative Claiming Program (MAC)

- Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) administers the Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC) Program at the federal level and reimburses states for allowable outreach activity performed under the Program.
- The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) administers the MAC Program at the state level.





The purpose of the MAC Program is to provide State
affiliated public agencies like Local Health Departments
(LHD) in Texas the opportunity to submit
reimbursement claims for administrative activities that
support the Medicaid program.



Approving the execution of an agreement with Texas
 Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) for the
 MAC Program which provide funds in an estimated
 amount up to \$50,000.00 for a total amount not to
 exceed \$250,000.00.

There is no impact to general fund



Staff recommends City Council ratify and approve the execution of the agreement with the HHSC and approve the acceptance of funds reimbursed from HHSC in an amount up to \$50,000.00 for a total amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 for the period ending March 31, 2026 for the Medicaid Administrative Claiming Program.
