**ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RIVER WALK LEASE  
AGREEMENT WITH SPIRITS OF SAN ANTONIO FOR RETAIL  
SPACE FOR A BASE TERM OF FIVE YEARS.**

**WHEREAS**, the previous term with tenant for a River Walk retail space under East Commerce Street Bridge expired on December 31, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the City approved to renew the lease term through December 31, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the lease term was again extended through December 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, tenant has operated in holdover status since the expiration of the previous term;

**NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee or the Director of the Center City Operations and Development Department or designee is authorized to execute a River Walk Lease Agreement with Spirits of San Antonio for retail space for a base term of five (5) years.

**SECTION 2.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
