Background

- On January 27, 2022, City Council authorized agreements with The Center for Health Care Services, Fiesta Youth, Healthy Futures of Texas, San Antonio AIDS Foundation, and San Antonio Nexus Connection, funded by the Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE) grant.
- The agreements serve to provide a peer recovery specialist for referrals to substance use disorder treatment programs, HIV and syphilis testing, outreach, and participation in the End Stigma End HIV Alliance.



Background

- Metro Health seeks to amend the agreements to expand services to include linkage to services, continued peer recruitment, HIV testing, outreach services, and expand the participation in the End Stigma End HIV Alliance to include data sharing.





Fiscal Impact

- Term: August 1, 2022 through July 31, 2023.
- Amount: No additional cost to Metro Health.
- There is no impact to the General Fund.



Recommendation

- Staff recommends City Council approve amendments to the agreements with The Center for Health Care Services, Fiesta Youth, Healthy Futures of Texas, San Antonio AIDS Foundation, and San Antonio Nexus Connection.
