The CAD system is a priority dispatch call-taking software.  These items are being purchased as Sole Source according to the provisions of Texas Statutes Local Government Code 252.022.07. No other course can supply the items listed nor can any comparable item fulfill the same requirements. Vendor acknowledges, with his/her signature, that all items offered are considered Sole Source.
