

RFCA #22-187856

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is authorized to execute an amendment to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) to increase the total compensation amount from \$73,600.00 to \$228,160.00 for the continued collection of data for the 2023 and 2024 Texas Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System survey (BRFSS) for a term ending September 30, 2025. Funding in the amount of \$150,880.00 through September 30, 2024, is available through the Health Disparities Grant. Funding for the future years will be supported by the Public Health Infrastructure Grant and is contingent upon acceptance of new grant funds by City Council.

SECTION 2. Funding is available from General Ledger 5201040, and Internal Order Number 136000001817 and Fund 2103600010 entitled “Health Disparities COVID”, for a total amount up to \$150,880.00. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to DSHS upon issuance of a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
