ORDINANCE

**ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF OLMOS PARK
TO GRANT THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO RIGHT-OF-ENTRY
PERMISSION TO INSTALL, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, AND REPLACE
A FLOOD GAUGE INCLUDING SIGNAGE WITHIN OLMOS PARK.**

WHEREAS, residents along Holland Avenue report property and street flooding during rain events when storm water runs down the local streets towards the intersection of Annie Street and Gillespie Street, where it enters a drainage ditch within the limits of the City of Olmos Park; and

WHEREAS, at the intersection of Annie Street and Gillespie Street water builds up to heights that could potentially be dangerous for vehicles and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, while Gillespie Street is within City of San Antonio limits, Annie Street and the intersection where the drainage channel begins are within the City of Olmos Park limits; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Interlocal Agreement (ILA) allows City staff or contractors to install or perform maintenance, repair, or replacement of a flood gauge within the right-of-way of the City of Olmos Park to alert drivers and pedestrians when water is too high and potentially dangerous; and

WHEREAS, an agreement is required to grant the City right-of-entry permission to complete this recommended safety measure by the City; and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2022, the Olmos Park City Council approved the proposed ILA, allowing the City of San Antonio to install and maintain the flood gauge at the intersection of Gillespie Street and Annie Street. Upon approval by Council, the City intends to have the installation completed by Spring 2023; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute execution of an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the City of Olmos Park to grant the City of San Antonio right-of-entry permission to install, maintain, repair, and replace a flood gauge, including signage within Olmos Park. A copy of the Agreement in substantially final form is attached as **Exhibit A**.
