**APPOINTING MICHAEL R. GALLAGHER AS THE TEMPORARY CITY  
COUNCIL MEMBER FOR DISTRICT 10.**

**WHEREAS**, on November 14, 2022, Councilmember Clayton Perry announced a temporary leave of absence from the City Council of the City of San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council invited qualified residents of District 10 to submit applications to the Office of the City Clerk as provided by Section 2-36 of the City Code to temporarily fill the office until Councilmember Perry returns to office; and

**WHEREAS**, on Wednesday, November 30, 2022, applicants provided comments, both written and oral, to the City Council on their qualifications and interest in serving during this time; and

**WHEREAS**, three applicants were selected for interviews at the A Session on December 1, 2022; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to appoint a temporary Councilmember for the District 10 City Council office; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Michael R. Gallagher is appointed to serve as the temporary District 10 member of the City Council of the City of San Antonio, to serve until Councilmember Clayton Perry returns from his leave of absence or for the remainder of the unexpired term, whichever is sooner.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes, or in the event eight affirmative votes are not received, on the tenth day after passage.


