Background

- Sister Cities International was initiated by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1956 to encourage greater friendship and understanding between other nations and U.S. cities. The City of San Antonio manages the Sister Cities program with its fourteen sister and friendship cities
- San Antonio has long celebrated its deep and historic ties with Mexico and has codified this connection with two sister and one friendship city:
 - Monterrey, Guadalajara, and Mexico City
- To recognize the importance of these ties, the Cit sponsored the 3rd US-Mexico Mayors' Community Summit from October 11-14 in San Diego, California and Tijuana, Baja California at the \$50,000 level.
