West Cargo Facility Rehabilitation

Scope of Work:

- Removal of existing roof/Installation of new roof
- ADA improvements including construction of ramps and a restroom
- Upgrading of electrical service to building
- Demolition of existing wall panels and installation of new installation, soffits and fascia
- Replacement of 52 overhead doors and 32 pedestrian doors
- Upgrading loading docs, security cameras and cameras



Fiscal Impact

Proposed Change Order

- Addresses delays due to supply chain issues
- \$107,328.73 - funding available in the FY 2023 – FY 2028 Capital Budget
