

ORDINANCE 2022-12-15-0971

AMENDING CHAPTER 19 OF THE CITY CODE TO UPDATE TRAFFIC CONTROL SCHEDULES OF DEVICES, ADDING 111 LOCATIONS CITYWIDE WHERE NEW INSTALLATIONS OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES HAVE OCCURRED, AND REMOVING 42 LOCATIONS CITYWIDE WHERE DEVICES HAVE BEEN ALTERED OR REMOVED.

WHEREAS, this ordinance will update various Traffic Control Schedules of Devices established in Chapter 19, Section 68(b) of the City Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, traffic control devices include, but are not limited to, stop signs, traffic signals, parking restrictions, and speed limit designations; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will enable consistent enforcement of on-street traffic regulations and will further City Council's policy to maintain an efficient and safe flow of traffic; and

WHEREAS, updated traffic control schedules will reflect new installations of traffic control devices and/or the removal of such devices at specified locations; and

WHEREAS, June 9, 2022 marked the latest update to the Traffic Control Schedules of Devices; and

WHEREAS, the following traffic control devices were added since the latest update to the Traffic Control Schedules of Devices on June 9, 2022:

WHEREAS, this ordinance amends the Traffic Control Schedules of Devices established in Chapter 19, Section 68(b) of the City Code to add 111 locations of new installations of traffic control devices and to remove 42 locations where devices have been altered or removed; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Public Works Department or designee, is authorized to amend the Traffic Control Schedules of Devices established in Chapter 19, Section 68(b) of the City Code to add 111 locations of new installations of traffic control devices and to remove 42 locations where devices have been altered or removed.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
