

ORDINANCE 2022-12-15-0994

APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR TOTAL MANAGEMENT OF GROWDON VEHICLE STORAGE FACILITY, TO MODIFY THE FEES CONTRACTOR MAY CHARGE.

WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 2017-09-21-0709 City Council approved a Professional Services Agreement for Total Management of Growdon Vehicle Storage Facility with Alanis Wrecker Service "Contractor," which expires on September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Contractor beginning with Covid closures began selling unclaimed vehicles through an online auction process; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has submitted a written request to modify the agreement to allow for an internet processing fee not to exceed ten percent of the total bid or five hundred dollars (\$500.00), whichever is less, **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. City Council hereby approves and the City Manager and designee, are hereby authorized to execute the amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for Total Management of Growdon Pound with Alanis Wrecker Service, that is materially and substantively the same as the agreement set forth in Exhibit A.


SECTION 2. Except as modified by this amendment, all the other terms and conditions in the Professional Services Agreement for Total Management of Growdon Vehicle Storage Facility remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Except as modified by this amendment, all the terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 2017-09-21-0709 remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective December 28, 2022.
