ORDINANCE

APPROVING A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE EXPEDITION SCHOOL FOR NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT RENTALS AT ELMENDORF LAKE PARK AND WOODLAWN LAKE PARK. LICENSE FEES GENERATED BY THIS AGREEMENT WILL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, the community has expressed the desire for expanded recreational opportunities and additional watercraft amenities in the San Antonio Parks system; and

WHEREAS, in support of this feedback, two Requests for Proposals (RFPs) were released for Management and Operations for Kayaking Concessions at Elmendorf Lake Park in District 5 and Woodlawn Lake Park in District 7; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2022, all submittals were reviewed by the evaluation committee members which included representatives from the City of San Antonio Parks and Recreation Department, City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department, and the San Antonio River Authority; and

WHEREAS, the evaluation committee recommended The Expedition School to provide non-motorized watercraft rentals and programming at both Elmendorf Lake Park and Woodlawn Lake Park; and

WHEREAS, the Expedition School was founded in 2006 and, in addition to non-motorized watercraft rentals, they provide quality, accessible, and affordable outdoor education programs as well as unique, hands-on, engaging, and professional water safety courses; and

WHEREAS, the Expedition School is committed to the environment and has, since 2006, removed over five tons of trash in and around Lady Bird Lake in Austin and is committed to bringing this level of conservation to San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, in addition to non-motorized watercraft rentals of canoes, single and tandem kayaks, and stand-up paddleboards, the Expedition School will offer structured outdoor programming that includes adaptive paddling, health and wellness programs, and camps; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee or the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or designee is authorized to execute a License Agreement with The Expedition School for non-motorized watercraft rentals at Elmendorf Lake Park in Council District 5 and Woodlawn Lake Park in Council District 7. Revenue generated from this agreement in the amount of \$1,000.00 annually will be deposited into the General Fund.

SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
