**ORDINANCE**

**ACCEPTING FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO  
\$126,360.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE  
GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE,  
CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE  
BULLET-RESISTANT SHIELD GRANT  
PROGRAM.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division has grant funds in an amount up to \$126,360.00 available to assist the San Antonio Police Department, under the bullet-resistant shield grant program; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds combined with a separate donation will provide funding for the purchase of about 48 ballistic shields, which will be available to counter the threat of active shooter incidents; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding will help provide up to two ballistic shields per shift, per substation, or a total of eight per substation; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant does not require an in-kind or cash match; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Chief of the San Antonio Police Department is the City's authorized official and is hereby authorized to accept the grant funds in an amount up to \$126,360.00 from the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office Criminal Justice Division Bullet-Resistant Shield Grant Program, for FY2023. In the event of loss or misuse of Criminal Justice Division grant funds, the City Council will return all funds to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.

**SECTION 2.** Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum of \$126,360.00 will be appropriated from the Office of the Governor. A final budget, which will include SAP Internal Orders and SAP GL Accounts, will be submitted by the SAPD upon award.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
